



Health and Safety Policy Statement

Dartford Football Club consider that the health and safety of its employees, customers and students is of great importance. The company therefore aims to ensure that the tasks it carries out achieve and maintain the highest reasonably practicable standards of health and safety for all employees and persons liable to be affected by them or their actions.

Dartford Football Club, through management at all levels, has a responsibility to ensure, as so far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and prevention of injuries to all employees and students whilst on site and visitors to the premises as identified within the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and its associated Regulations.

In accepting this responsibility, Dartford Football Club will as far as is reasonably practical, strive to;

- Provide and maintain plant and systems at work that are safe and without risk to health.
- Ensure safety and absence of risk to health in connection with the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances.
- Provide such information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to promote the health and safety of its employees, students and customers.
- Provide and maintain work places in a condition that is safe and without risk to health, including means access and egress from the workplace.
- Provide and maintain work environments that are safe, without risks to health with adequate facilities and arrangements for students and employee's welfare at work.
- Ensure that company employees are fit for work they are required to do. Ensure that disability is prevented and loss of working time due to injury or illness is minimal.
- Monitor health and safety policies, procedures and systems for maintaining a healthy safe environment free from hazards that may affect employees, customer and students.

Employee's and students are reminded that they have a legal responsibility to take reasonable care for the health and safety of themselves and others by adopting the safe working practices given to them either written or verbal communication, such that they do not put themselves, fellow students or employees at risk.

With a view to promoting good practice covering health and safety at work, Dartford Football Club requires the co-operation and encourages the involvement of all employees and students.
